Introduction to Ancient Indian Numismatics

REPORT

A non conventional / skill development certificate course " Introduction to Ancient Indian Numismatics" was conducted from 09/08/16 to 13/08/16 for T Y B A (History) students.

The resource person for the same was Ms. Nalini Naik, Curator of Indian Customs and Central Excise Museum, Panaji. The total number of students that attended the course were 14.

The objective of the course was to provide the students in-depth knowledge of Ancient Indian Numismatics which is not included in the syllabus of B A (History). A detailed study of numismatics or study of coins is significant / relevant to the student of history as it is an important source for the study of history.

The content of the course included introduction to numismatics, its history, study of coins belonging to ancient India (Kushanas, Satavahanas, Guptas and the Indo – Greeks).

The course concluded with a study of contribution of numismatics to Indian history. Practicals were also concluded.
