# **CHIASMA (2015-2020)**

'Chiasma' is an inter institutional event organized by the Department of Biotechnology, Dhempe College of Arts and Science since 2015. Prior to this event, the department organized a 'Biotech Week'. With an overwhelming response from various higher secondary schools, the event was later reframed and renamed as 'CHIASMA – *Bridging the Gap*'. The name depicted the intention and initiative to create awareness among young students about Biotechnology as an advanced field of science and its scope and also to provide a platform for undergraduate students of Biotechnology to showcase their potential.

# Objectives:

- To promote scientific inquisitiveness among budding young students.
- To display the life science skills for the students of Higher Secondary Schools of Goa.
- To encourage students to take interest in Biotechnology as their career option.
- To allow students to sharpen their creativity by motivating them to make models and exhibits.
- To impart confidence in students giving them an exposure while demonstrating their exhibits to the students of Higher Secondary Schools and faculty members.

## ■ <u>2015 – 2016</u>

The Department of Biotechnology organized the Exhibition cum Event "Chiasma" on 01.12.2015 and 02.12.2015. The exhibition was visited by young enthusiastic students from different Higher Secondary Schools and Colleges from Goa. The event included posters, experiments and small projects based on the theme of Biotechnology that were displayed for the students. The Events were organized for Higher Secondary students from various institutions in Goa.

#### **2016 – 2017**

Chiasma 2016was hosted by the Department of Biotechnology, DCT's Dhempe College of Arts and Science, on 06.12.2016 and 07.12.2016 for students of various higher secondary schools. These included M.E.S Higher Secondary School, VasantraoDempo Higher Secondary School of Arts & Science - Miramar, S.S.Samiti Higher secondary school of science – Ponda and high school like Sharda Mandir School - Miramar. Various projects, posters and models on Biotechnology and different instruments used in Biotechnology-related experiments were showcased.

#### **2017 - 2018**

The Department of Biotechnology organised Chiasma 2017 under 'Inspire the Next' Science Exhibition on 12.12.2017 and 13.12.2017. The F.Y.B.Sc. and S.Y.B.Sc. students had put up exhibits pertaining to different fields of Biotechnology-Environmental Biotechnology, Food Biotechnology, Plant Biotechnology, Animal Cell Culture, Immunology, Zoology, Molecular Biology, Industrial Biotechnology, Biochemistry and Biological Engineering. Projects and Models of each field of Biotechnology were displayed. The principle and working of the laboratory instruments like Laminar Air Flow, Flourescent Microscope, Inverted Microscope, gel Electrophoresis unit and many more were explained by the T.Y.B.Sc. students.

Around 600 students and faculty from 8 colleges attended the exhibition making it a success.
