INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS REGARDING THE ONLINE (CBCS) SEM I and III SUPPLEMENTARY EXAM COMMENCING FROM 02/08/2021.

- 1. Question will be send by email to the students. One will be pdf as attachment and one in word file (to answer), pasted in the email
- 2. Only the HOD will be in contact with the students during the exam day and no other teacher will communicate with the students at the time of exam in any mode like Google classroom/ meet or WhatsApp etc.
- 3. The student should communicate to the HOD immediately after receiving the mail.
- 4. The students will either type and send the answer on the word document provided or may write and scan/photograph. It is the responsibility of the student to send a clear readable picture. It is recommended that the student should download Adobe scan on their mobiles for scanning the written answer book.
- 5. The students should reply to the mail sent with the answers and not compose another mail.
- 6. It is mandatory for the students to save the answer paper submitted by them. 7. The students should mention the total number of pages uploaded.
- 8. The time duration of the examination is two hours. Student should be required to upload their answer script latest by 1.00 pm.
- 9. The question paper will be of 40 Marks if the SEE is of 80 Marks and 30 Marks if the SEE is of 60 Marks and 40 Marks if the SEE is of 120 Marks which will be scaled up to 120 Marks.
- 10. There will be two main questions:
- Q1. Answer any 5 out of 8 2x5 = 10 Marks
- Q2. Answer any 4 out of 6 or 6 out of 8 4x5 = 20/30 Marks
- 11. The student has to enter the Roll Number, Class, Subject, Date, and Paper Code. /title and page number on every answer paper uploaded. No other indication such as name should be written on the answer sheet.
- 12. The students should upload the answer sheet immediately on the exam day itself and only using the official email ID.
- 13. The question paper shall be uploaded on the official email Id and (WhatsApp on if needed) at 10 a.m. on the day of the exam.
- 14. There shall be only one question paper per paper title, so all the students are required to be online on the day of exam.
