

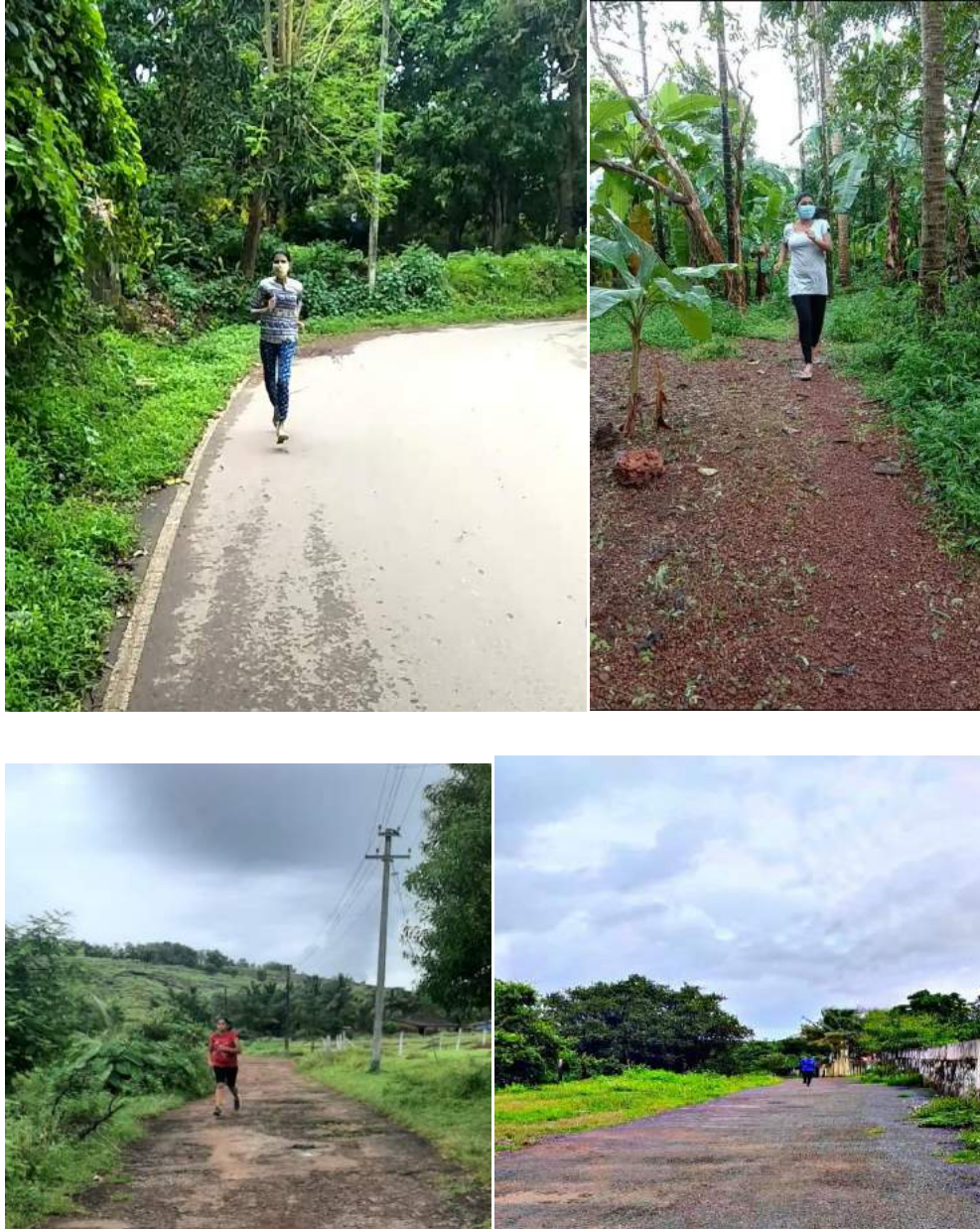

National Education Policy Awareness Campaign

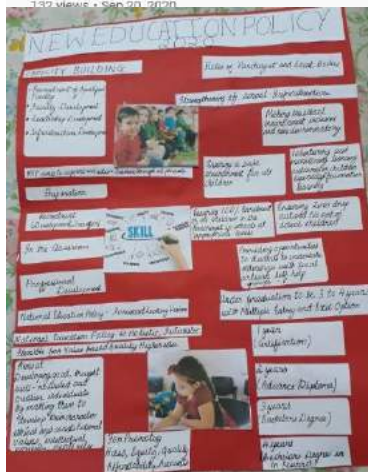

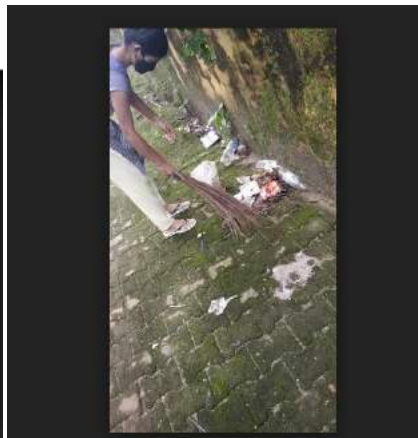
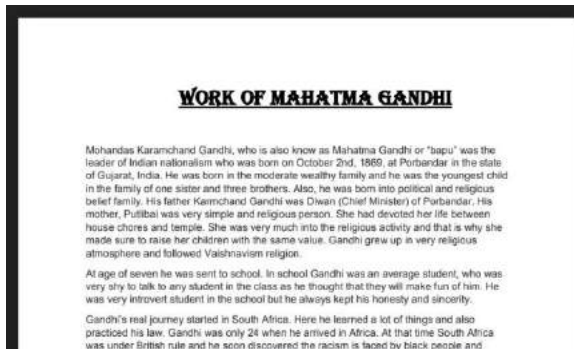


Screening of Documentary- Mahatma Gandhi: Pilgrim of Peace

4. Swachhta Abhiyaan- cleanliness activity in surrounding (105 participant-volunteers)



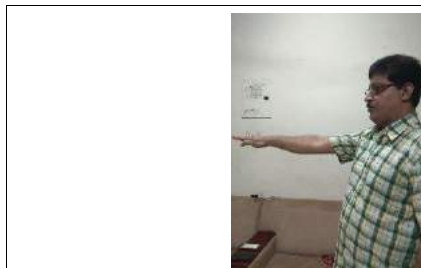
Public awareness to influence public behavior on Covid19

Celebration of Rashtriya Ekata Divas on 31st October 2020

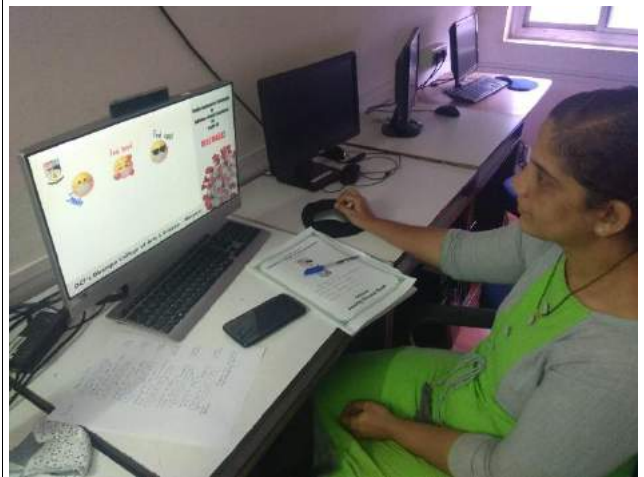
The following activities were held in the Dhempe College of Arts and Science, Miramar on the occasion of Rashtriya Ekata Divas on 31 October 2020.



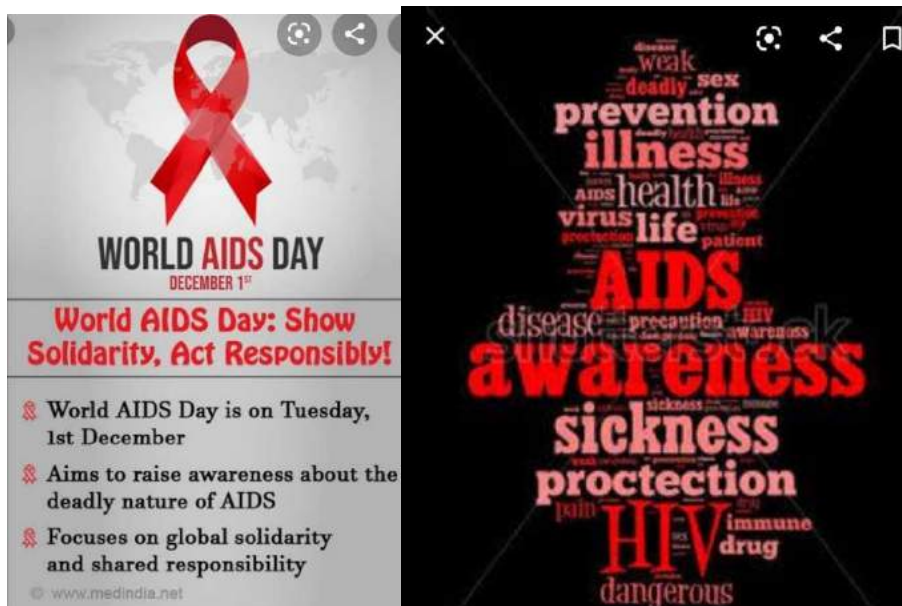




Observation of World AIDS Day on 1st December 2020 (campaign through social media)

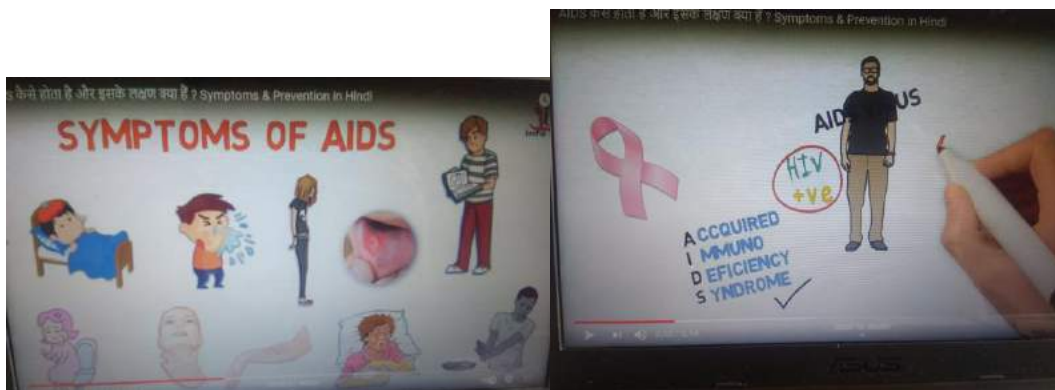
