MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR THE BLIND
SANTA CRUZ, GOA

And

DCT'S DHEMPE COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE, MIRAMAR, GOA

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into and executed by and between the **NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR THE BLIND** at Santa Cruz, Goa, represented by its **PRESIDENT**, and hereinafter referred to as **NAB** and the **DCT'S DHEMPE COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE** at Miramar, Goa represented by its Administrative Head of the Institution, **PRINCIPAL**.

WHEREAS, NAB is an organization that works with the sole aim to help the Visually Impaired persons in the State of Goa, in the field of Education, Vocational Training, Computers, Theatre, Sports etc.

WHEREAS, DHEMPE COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE, MIRAMAR is a non-profit institution of education in Goa managed by Dempo Charities Trust with a vision "To be a Premier Institution of India for the Academic Excellence and Holistic Development of Individuals" and a mission: To be committed towards making Education Inclusive, Interactive and to enhance Education by a Knowledge-driven, Technology-enabled and Learner-friendly Pedagogy with an endeavour to develop Employable citizens with Humane Values and Social Commitment".

With this mission of making education inclusive promote human values and social commitment; **DCT'S DHEMPE COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE** would like to collaborate with National Association for the Blind, Goa State Branch for development of blind students.

I. SCOPE AND AREAS OF COLLABORATION

Collaboration between NAB and DHEMPE COLLEGE with the aim of including the blind in educational mainstream and their holistic development between the two parties. NAB and DHEMPE COLLEGE shall:

- a. Collaborate in inclusion programmes.

II. IMPLEMENTATION AND MANAGEMENT

In implementing this MOU, each party will be guided by the availability of resources, including financial resources, for any activities to be conducted. The expenses incurred under this MOU will be financed in accordance with the supplements to this MOU approved by both the parties in writing.

III. EFFECTIVITY

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be signed by the authorized representatives of both parties and shall take effect on the date the last authorized representative affixes his/her signature and shall remain valid for a period of TEN years unless sooner terminated when one of the parties notifies the other in writing of its intention to terminate the MOU, in which case, the MOU will terminate six months from the date of such notification. This MOU may be further renewed or extended upon mutual understanding between the parties, which shall be made not later than six months prior to the termination date.

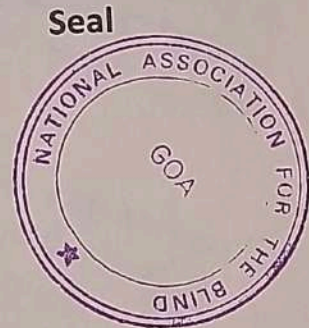
