1. Dance- Dance – Transversal (Game):

Students are first taught about the various angles made by parallel lines and transversal. The corresponding angles, alternate interior angles, Alternate exterior angles, linear pairs. Once the students are familiar, they were made to play the dance-dance-transversal game. The music was played and students were made to dance. Once the music stops, a pair of angles name was flashed, they were supposed to stand on those pair of angles. Students had initially some difficulty in identifying the angles but as they played the game, they became more familiar with angles and enjoyed the game.
