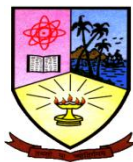

## ❖ Induction program for NSS volunteers on 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> October 2021

An NSS induction programme was organised in an online mode for the newly enrolled NSS volunteers for the year 2021-22 on 5th October 2021 at 11.30am for the FY and SY BSc students and on 7th October 2021 at 2.30pm for the FY and SY BA students.

Mr. Dinanath Parab (NSS Incharge Programme Officer), Dr. Raghav Gadgil and Ms Shilpa Naik, NSS Programme Officers welcomed the new volunteers to the NSS family.

Mr. Parab briefed the students with the history and importance of National Service Scheme and its objectives with the help of a power point presentation. He explained a vast array of social activities that are carried out under the NSS programme. A presentation of various activities carried out by the Dhempe College of Arts & Science NSS Unit in the past years was displayed to the students.

Mr Parab also mentioned that there are NSS marks that will figure out in the academics for volunteers completing 60 hours of NSS activities per semester in their NSS diaries. The eligibility criterion for obtaining the NSS marks will be purely based on the verified activities that are participated and completed by the NSS volunteer during the semester.

A total of 78 NSS volunteers for the BSc and 51 NSS volunteers for the BA participated in the induction programme.

A total of 157 NSS volunteers for the BSc and 97 NSS volunteers for the BA stream are enrolled for NSS for the Academic year 2021-22.

A slogan competition was held amongst the volunteers of Dhempe College on the topic “Deaddiction”. A total of 33 volunteers participated and submitted their slogans.

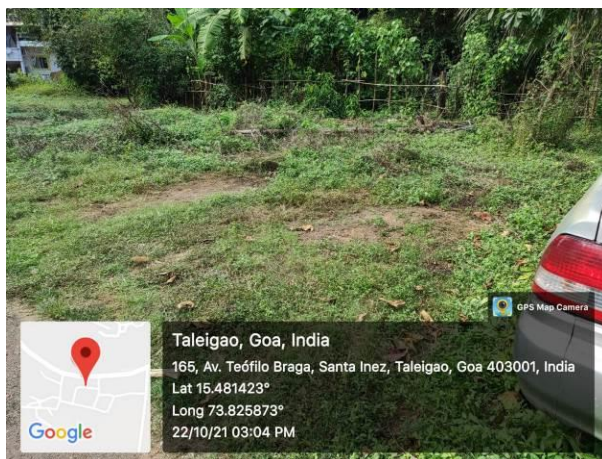

## ❖ TOBACCO FREE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION on 20-10-2021

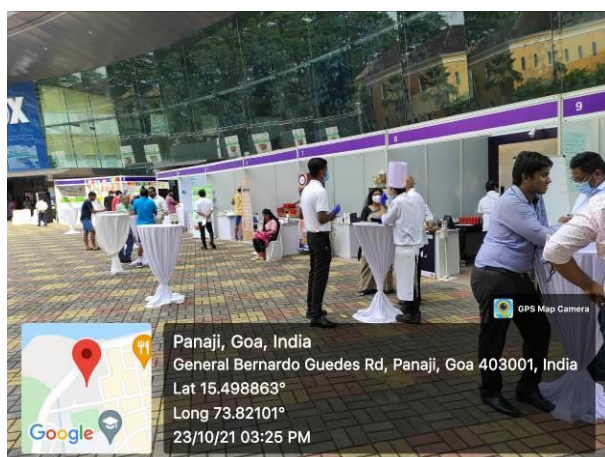

### ❖ NATIONAL YOUTH PARLIAMENT (10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> November 2021)

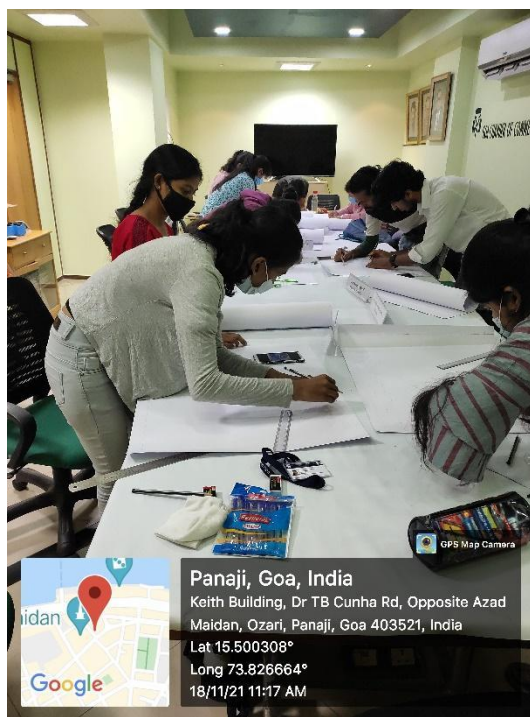

### Phase II

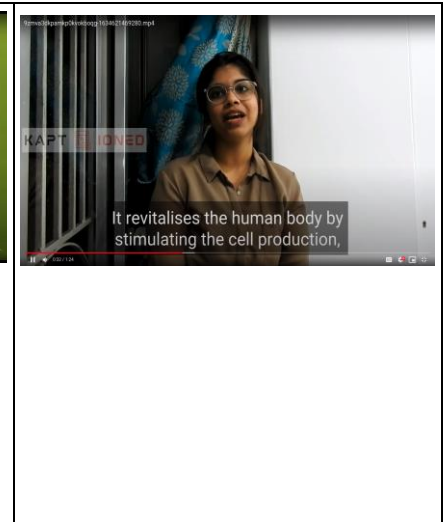

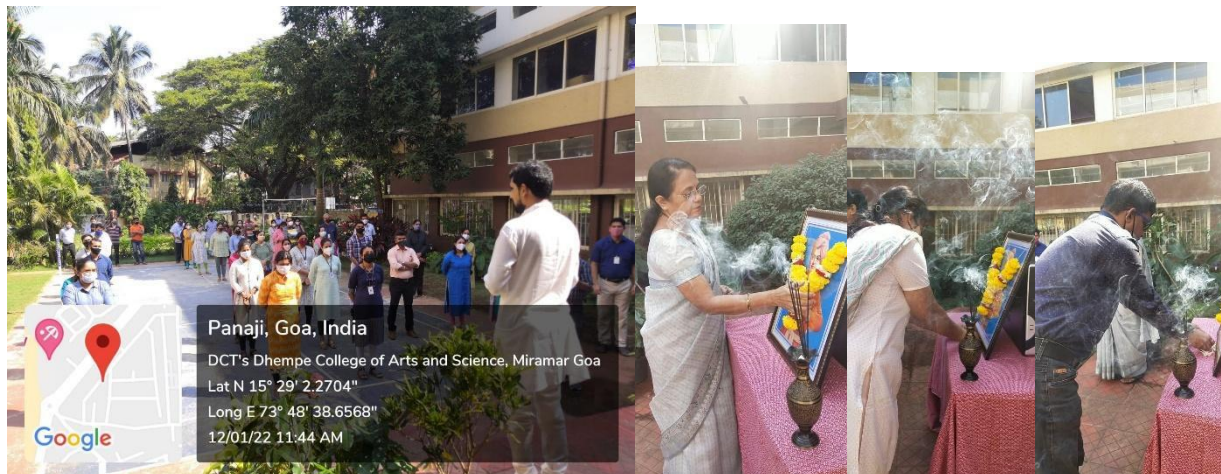
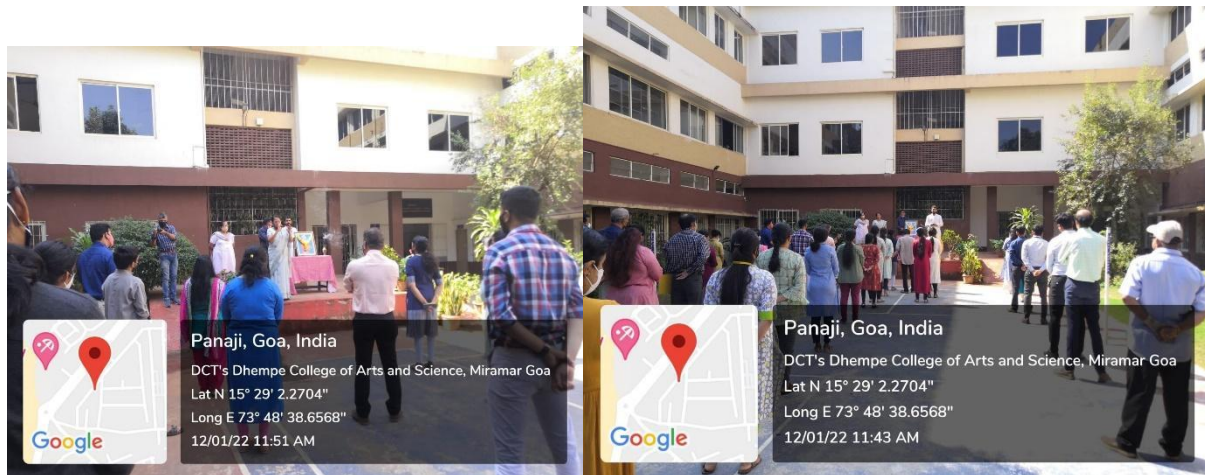


## ❖ Swami Vivekanand Birth Anniversary and National Youth Day 12<sup>th</sup> January 2022

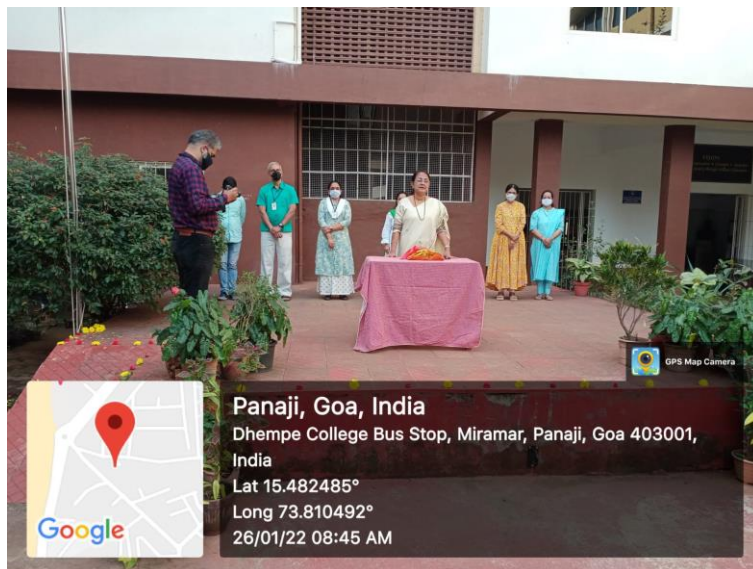

NSS volunteer Yashasvi Gaunekar attended a week-long National Integration Camp at Gulbarga University from 03/03/2022 to 09/03/2022.

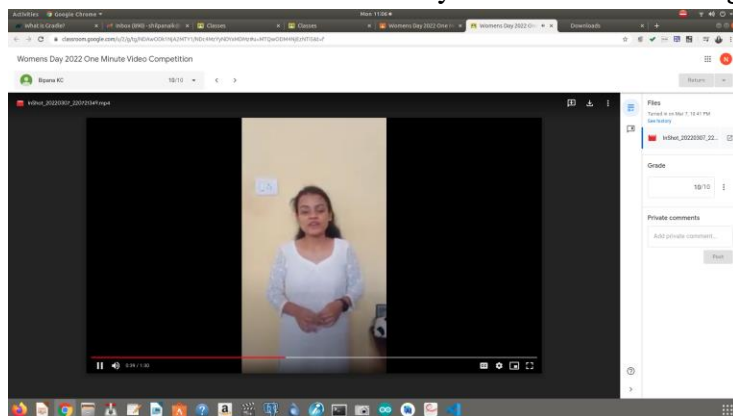


❖ **Webcast of National Youth Parliament Festival 2022 on 10th & 11th March,2022**
