- and has secured at least a second class at graduatelevel, or has secured an average of 50% marks in the previous three examinations. (Relaxation of 5% to the reserved categories viz. SC/ST/OBC).
- (ii) The candidate should have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR or similar test accredited by UGC like SLET/SET.
- (iii) However, candidates, who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 as incorporated in the relevant Goa University Statute, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
- If candidates fulfilling essential qualifications (ii) and (iii) are not available, then
 candidates fulfilling essential qualifications (i) may be considered for appointment on
 Contract/Lecture Basis.
- Pay scale and service conditions shall be as laid down by Goa University/Government of Goa. All other requirements prescribed by UGC/Goa University and Government of Goa shall be applicable.
- Candidates belonging to O.B.C./S.T./EWS category should enclose Caste Certificate from competent authorities of Government of Goa.
- Candidates belonging toPwD category should produce a disability certificate of
 minimum 40% from competent authority. Candidates applying for the post reserved
 for PwD should indicate whether he/she belongs to SC/ST/OBC/EWS. The necessary
