#### 1. My Story Session by successful Innovators

A mentoring session by a successful innovator was conducted on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2022 in Swami Vivekananda Hall at 11:00 am. The resource person for the session was Ms. Nandini Dessai, founder of Nandini's Bodifying – Skin and Bodycare products. Ms. Nandini spoke about her entrepreneurial journey and motivated the young audience to pursue their dreams. She also mentioned that she had very little financial support but still managed to search for alternative resources and used all her challenges to her advantage. She laid emphasis on advertisement for promotion of any product or service to reach out to a larger audience. A total of 75 students and 6 faculty members attended the session.

The session was co-ordinated by Dr. Preethi Pandit and Ms. Siddhi Parsekar.



#### 2. "My Story-Motivational session by Startup founder"

A seminar on "My Story-Motivational session by Startup founder" was organized on 6<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 between The seminar was organized to motivate students towards startups and entrepreneurship. The distinguished resource persons for the seminar were Mr. Hrishikesh Bhandari (Chief executive officer and Co-founder, Saafwater, Goa) and Mr. Sanket Marathe (Head of Technology and Co-founder Saafwater, Goa)

Mr. Hrishikesh Bhandari delivered the lecture on the topic "Our Journey from zero to One"

He informed the students about different hardships, ups and downs and success stories of his journey of starting different companies during his startup carrier. He encouraged the students to make use their subject knowledge and ideas to develop useful products and serve the society and in turn make their carriers successful. He motivated the youth to take risks and be innovative though hard work and dedication which are the fundamentals of success. Mr. Sanket Marathe, gave insights about the technical aspects of the products developed at Saafwater, Goa. He informed that their company provides Real-time artificial intelligence based services for the testing of water for the pollutants all over the world.



The seminar was attended by 70 students from TY.B.Sc and M.Sc. and 11 faculty members. The seminar was coordinated by Dr. Bhanudas Naik, Assistant and Dr. Karuna Singh.

#### 3. Workshop on Entrepreneurship and Innovation as a career opportunity

A workshop on Entrepreneurship and Innovation as a career opportunity was on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2022 in Swami Vivekananda Hall at 12:00 pm. The resource person for the session was Ms. Vimi Salgaonkar, official of MGNCRE- Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Entrepreneurship. She presented on Rural entrepreneurship and its importance in a developing country such as ours. She highlighted the significance of rural entrepreneurship and made the students aware of the different schemes offered by the Government to budding rural entrepreneurship. The session ended with multiple questions and was fruitful to the students. The workshop was co-ordinated by Dr. Preethi Pandit and Ms. Siddhi Parsekar. A total of 75 students and 6 faculty members participated in the workshop.



#### 4. Visit to Incubation Centre

A visit to incubation centre at the innovation hub -incubation unit of the Science Centre at Panaji Goa was conducted on 9<sup>th</sup> march 2023. A volunteer explained the working of the incubation centre and he mentioned the facilities and services that is provided to students of the

incubation centre. He encouraged the students to pursue their ideas and convert them into working models or prototypes using the incubation centre when needed. The visit was fruitful and the students were happy to see and learn the working of an incubation unit. Dr. Preethi Pandit and Dr. Chandan Naik with a team of 12 SYBSc students participated in the visit.



#### 5. Outreach programme on Innovation and entrepreneurship

An outreach program on Innovation and entrepreneurship was conducted by IIC membersat Hedgewar school, Cujira Goa on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2023. Dr. Preethi Pandit (Member of Team IIC), introduced the concept of IIC and also mentioned the role of AICTE and MHRD in conducting activities for the promotion of innovation and entrepreneurship in India. The resource person for the session was Ms. Gail Zacharia who addressed the students of 8<sup>th</sup> standard class. She spoke on entrepreneurship and the difference between businessman and entrepreneur. She encouraged students to be innovative and create a new market of important products and services. She elaborated on skills of an entrepreneur such as being intuitive and a risk taker. She discussed about the types of entrepreneurs. The session was interactive and the students were encouraged to innovate and design prototypes to be successful entrepreneurs in the future. A total of 42 students attended the session.





## 6. Session on 'How to plan for startup legal and ethical steps'

Aa session on 'How to Plan for Startup Legal and Ethical Steps' was organized on 21st July 2023 at 10am in Audio Visual Room, The resources person for the session was Mr Edwin Cortez, Associate Professor Department of Economics. The resource person focused on importance of start-ups with inputs on 5 P's that is Product, Price, Promotion, Place, and People, knowledge about the legal and ethical aspects of the startups. This session for students on startup legal and ethical aspects equipped them with essential knowledge and skills to navigate the complexities of the business world responsibly while it fosters a culture of integrity and responsible entrepreneurship. The session was organised by Mr. Snehal Harmalkar and Ms. Sendra Florencia Pereira. A total of 21 students and 03 faculty members benefited from the session.





#### 7. Visit to Incubation Centre

A visit to the Incubation centre of Goa Science Centre was conducted on 21<sup>st</sup> July 2023.

The main objective was to engage the students in hands-on learning and explore various scientific concepts and gain practical knowledge about science and technology through interactive exhibits. The centre aims to promote scientific curiosity and critical thinking among visitors, especially students, to foster an interest in science-related subjects. The Project Officer Mrs Sampada Naik and Mrs Shubada Pednekar addressed the students on the necessity of having basic concepts of Science and also encouraged us to undertake scientific projects with societal impact.

The students also had an opportunity to visit the Innovation Hub equipped with several well-designed laboratory sections that cover a wide range of scientific topicslike Chemistry, Physics and Biology.

The students were encouraged to start sharing and working on their ideas so that they can be developed into products for betterment of society and they were also motivated to participate in the various workshops conducted by the company.


A total of 38 students and 04 faculty members attended the workshop.

Miss Siddhi Parsekar and Dr Trupti Jadhav were the organising secretary for the workshop.




# 9.Poster competition on the topic "Business and linkage with Innovation Ambassadors"
