

IIC Report 6.0 Calendar year

1. The Institution's Innovation Council of the college organized a session on "My Story – Motivational Session by Successful Entrepreneur/ Startup Founder" on 16th October 2023, Monday. The resource person for the session was Mr. Chaitanya Malik, Founder, Dr. Malik's Farm., Pernem-Goa.

The resource person narrated his journey from an engineer to a successful Goan farmer, also mentioned that he didn't choose the beaten path and instead went for agriculture and dairy farming and now has his own successful brand known as the Dr Malik's Farm at Hasapur, Pernem.

He further spoke about the hurdles he faced, and instead of quitting how he accepted challenges and the solutions actually helped them in expanding their firm with introduction of new products.

A total of 25 students and 6 faculty attended the session.
