Place: Miramar, Panjim-Goa


Hours: 20


# 2. Theme: Waste Management (Adopted Village/Community)

Place: Merces, Goa



### 3. Theme: Greenery (Campus)


Activity: Gardening / Landscaping

Activity: Hands on training on creating scientific exhibits/experiments and showcasing their significance in daily life


Place: Miramar, Panjim-Goa

# 5. Theme: Sanitation & Hygiene (Adopted Village/Community)


Activity: Talk on menstrual hygiene and sanitary waste disposal for school girls

SBSI interns conducted an awareness camp on menstrual hygiene for secondary school girls at Our Lady of Merces High School as a part of Swachh Bharat Student Intership activity on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2023. The objective was to create awareness on importance of menstrual hygiene and impact of improper disposal on the environment and health. Students covered topics like how to deal with menstrual pain, menstrual hygiene, proper use and disposal of sanitary products and what are the different period products used during the menses.
