- (i) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university and has secured at least a second class at graduate level, or has secured an average of 50% marks in the previous three examinations.
- (ii) The candidate should have cleared the National Eligibility Test(NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR or similar test accredited by UGC like SLET/SET.
- (iii) However, candidates, who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 as incorporated in the relevant Goa University Statute, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
- If candidates fulfilling essential qualifications (ii) and (iii) are not available, then candidates fulfilling essential qualifications (i) may be considered for appointment
- Pay scale and service conditions shall be as laid down by Goa University/Government of Goa. All other requirements prescribed by UGC/Goa University and Government of Goa shall be applicable.
